

## **DIRECTIONS BEGIN AT FOUR MILE FORK (RT 1 & RT 208), FREDERICKSBURG.**

**Atlee Youth Sports Complex:** Drive South on I-95 to the Atlee/Elmont exit (Exit 86), turn left onto Sliding Hill Road, turn right onto New Ashcake Road, turn left onto Whippoorwill Road, turn left into the Sports Complex.

**Bowling Green Little League Park:** Drive South on Route 1 to Route 17 (Mills Drive). Turn left, drive 6 miles to intersection of Route 2 & 17 (New Post). Turn right onto Route 2 South (toward Bowling Green), drive 13 miles, turn right on Paige Road (Route 605). Caroline Little League Park is 1 mile ahead on left, at 15496 Paige Road.

**Deep Run High School:** Drive I-95 South for 42 miles to I-295 (exit 84), and go west toward Charlottesville. Take the Nuckols Road Exit (exit 51-B), go to the second traffic signal, and turn left on Twin Hickory Drive. Take a right at the next traffic signal, which is the main entrance to the school.

**Essex Little League:** Drive Route 1 South to Route 17 (Mills Drive). Turn left, drive 47 miles to the town of Tappahannock. Just before intersection of Route 17 and 360, turn right onto Marsh Street. Complex is at the end of Marsh Street.

**Loriella Park:** Drive North on Route 1 to second traffic signal at Harrison Road. Turn left on Harrison, drive 3 miles to Leavells Road. Turn left, drive about 1 mile to the second traffic signal, and Loriella Park is on the right.

**Patriot Park:** Drive South on Route 1 South for about 5 miles, turn right on Massaponax Church Road. Drive 1 mile, turn right on Smith Station Road. Drive 3/10 of a mile, and Patriot Park is on the left, just past Parkside Elementary School, and the Spotsylvania YMCA.

**Rappahannock Electric Cooperative:** Drive North on Route 1 approximately 50 yards, turn left on Industrial Drive. Drive approximately ½ mile, turn right on Industrial Court. REC is at the end of the street, 247 Industrial Court. FUA meets in the REC training facility, to the right and behind the main building.

**Virginia Sports Complex:** Drive South on Route 1 for approximately 22 miles (into Caroline County, through Ladysmith), complex is about 4 miles south of Ladysmith on right at 22182 Jefferson Davis Highway. **Alternate:** Take I-95 South at Spotsylvania (Exit 126), to Ladysmith (Exit 110), Route 639. Turn right at end of ramp, drive ½ mile to Route 1. Turn left on Route 1 South, complex is about 4 miles south of Ladysmith on right at 22182 Jefferson Davis Highway.

## **FUA HIGH SCHOOL DIRECTIONS**

**Caroline High School:** For **baseball**, take Route 1 South to Route 17 (Mills Drive). Turn left, drive 6 miles to intersection of Route 2 & 17 (New Post). Turn right, drive 15 miles, through the town of Bowling Green, and Caroline Stadium is ½ mile south of town on the left. For **softball**, take I-95 South at Spotsylvania (Exit 126), to Ladysmith (Exit 110), Route 639. Turn left at end of ramp on Route 639, drive 5 miles to Route 207. Turn right on Route 207, school is 1 mile ahead on the left. Field is just past the school building, behind the main parking lot.

**Chancellor High School:** Drive North on Route 1 to second traffic signal at Harrison Road. Turn left on Harrison, drive 4 miles to Chancellor Park Drive. Turn left, and the school is just ahead. The softball field is on the right side of the school building. The baseball field is behind the school on the left.

**Colonial Beach High School:** Drive Route 1 North to interchange with Route 3. Take Route 3 East for 18 miles, through the town of King George. Turn left on Route 205, drive 13 miles into town of Colonial Beach. Turn left on First Street, and the school is two blocks ahead on the right.

**Courtland High School:** From Four Mile Fork, drive West on Route 208 (Courthouse Road), approximately 4 miles to Smith Station Road. Turn left on Smith Station Road, and the school is ½ mile ahead on the left.

**Eastern View High School:** Route 1 North to Harrison Road, turn left. Drive 5 miles to end of Harrison Road at Route 3. Turn left on Route 3 West. Drive approximately 22 miles, turn right onto Stevensburg Road (Route 663). Drive about 1½ miles, then turn left on Green Corner Road (Route 666). School is 3 miles ahead on the right.

**Fredericksburg Christian High School:** Drive South on Route 1 to Route 17 (Mills Drive). Turn left, drive 5 miles to Thornton Rolling Road (Route 609). Turn right, and the school is 1 mile ahead on the right. Baseball field is to the right of the school, and Softball field is behind the school.

**James Monroe High School:** For **baseball**, take Route 1 North to Learning Lane (next to Purvis Ford). Parking lot and field are at the top of the hill on the left. For **softball**, take Route 1 North to Fall Hill Avenue, just past Mary Washington Hospital. Turn right, drive one block to Washington Avenue. Turn right, school and field are ahead on the right.

**King George High School:** Drive Route 1 North to interchange with Route 3. Take Route 3 East for 18 miles, through the intersection of Route 206. Drive another ½ mile, turn left onto Foxes Way, and the school is just ahead. Baseball and Softball fields are behind the parking lot.

**Massaponax High School:** Drive Route 1 South for approximately 8 miles, school is on left side of Route 1. Enter parking lot on the right side of the school, fields are behind the school.

**Northumberland High School:** Drive Route 1 South to Route 17 (Mills Drive). Turn left, drive 47 miles to the town of Tappahannock. Turn left at second traffic signal (Route 360), and drive 27 miles, through the town of Warsaw to the town of Heathsville. Turn right onto Academic Lane, and the school is on the left.

**Quantico High School:** Take Route 1 North to Route 3, then drive Route 3 West to I-95 (Exit 130). Drive North on I-95 to Quantico Exit (Exit 148). After passing through the base security gate, take the second left (Purvis Road), next to the McDonalds. Drive approximately 3 miles, the school, baseball and softball fields are located on the left.

**Rappahannock Community College:** Drive Route 1 South to Route 17 (Mills Drive). Turn left, drive 47 miles to the town of Tappahannock. Turn left at second traffic signal (Route 360), and drive 7 miles into the town of Warsaw. RCC campus is on the right side of Route 360. Field is beside the campus on the left.

**Rappahannock High School:** Drive Route 1 South to Route 17 (Mills Drive). Turn left, drive 47 miles to the town of Tappahannock. Turn left at second traffic signal (Route 360), and drive 7 miles, into and through the town of Warsaw. School is on Route 360 just beyond the intersection of Route 360 and Route 3. Baseball field is behind the school, softball field is beside the school.

**Riverbend High School:** Drive North on Route 1 to second traffic signal at Harrison Road. Turn left on Harrison, drive 6 miles until Harrison Road ends at Route 3. Turn left on Route 3 West, drive ½ mile to Spotswood Furnace Road (Route 620). Turn right, school is just ahead on the right.

**Washington & Lee High School:** Drive Route 1 North to interchange with Route 3. Take Route 3 East for 41 miles, to the town of Montross. Drive through Montross, school is on the right side of Route 3. Parking lots, baseball and softball fields are behind the school.

## **FUA MIDDLE SCHOOL DIRECTIONS**

**Battlefield Middle:** Drive North on Route 1 to second traffic signal at Harrison Road. Turn left on Harrison, drive 3 miles to Leavells Road. Turn left on Leavells Road, school is ½ mile ahead on the right, next to Battlefield Elementary School.

**Caroline Middle:** Take I-95 South at Spotsylvania (Exit 126), to Exit 110 (Ladysmith), Route 639. At end of ramp, turn left on Route 639, drive 5 miles to Route 207. Turn right on Route 207, drive 1 mile to Devils Three Jump Road. Turn left, school is just ahead on the left.

**Chancellor Middle:** Drive North on Route 1 to second traffic signal at Harrison Road. Turn left on Harrison, drive 4 miles to Chancellor Park Drive. Turn left, and the school is just ahead.

**Freedom Middle:** From Four Mile Fork, drive West on Route 208 (Courthouse Road), approximately 4 miles to Smith Station Road. Turn right on Smith Station Road, and the school is 5 miles ahead on the left.

**Montross Middle:** Drive Route 1 North to interchange with Route 3. Take Route 3 East for 41 miles, to the town of Montross. Drive through Montross, school is on the right side of Route 3, about 2 miles past Washington & Lee High School.

**Post Oak Middle:** Drive Route 1 South to Thornburg, turn right on Route 606. Drive West, approximately 5 miles to intersection of Route 606 and Route 208 (Snell). Drive straight through intersection, another 3 miles, and Spotsylvania High School and Post Oak Middle Schools are on the left. Field is behind Spotsylvania High School.

**Thornburg Middle:** Drive Route 1 South, approximately 10 miles, to Larkin Chew Road. Turn left on Larkin Chew Road. (There is a sign on Route 1 directing you to the school). Field is behind the school.

**Walker Grant Middle:** For Baseball, take Route 1 North to Learning Lane (next to Purvis Ford). Parking lot and field is at the top of the hill on the left.
